- i. P. 9, title of Box Figure 6: "Flow of Health Information"
- ii. P. 11, 2<sup>nd</sup> par: delete last sentence, i.e. "This disconnect is bound to be magnified with the impacts of climate change."
- P. 14, Box 1.4, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> paragraphs should be merged to read: "At least three other charts can be found (i.e. in David et al. [1992] and Tillah [2011]). All three are cosmetic versions of each other in any case...."
- iv. P. 32, 3<sup>rd</sup> par, 3<sup>rd</sup> sentence should read: "46 out of a total of 80 provinces and Metro Manila, or 57.5 percent, have urban population shares of less than 25 percent ...Thirtytwo provinces, or 40 percent, are in the intermediate stage... "
- v. P. 36, 1<sup>st</sup> par, last sentence should read: "For instance, Eastern Samar and **Camarines Sur or Albay** are relatively poor, but there is a greater concentration of poor people in **the latter two**."
- vi. P. 36, 2<sup>nd</sup> par, 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> sentences should read: "Besides Eastern Samar, other examples of provinces which are lagging and relatively sparsely populated are **Agusan del Norte** and Davao Oriental. On the other hand, Nueva Ecija is like **Albay** lagging and more densely populated."
